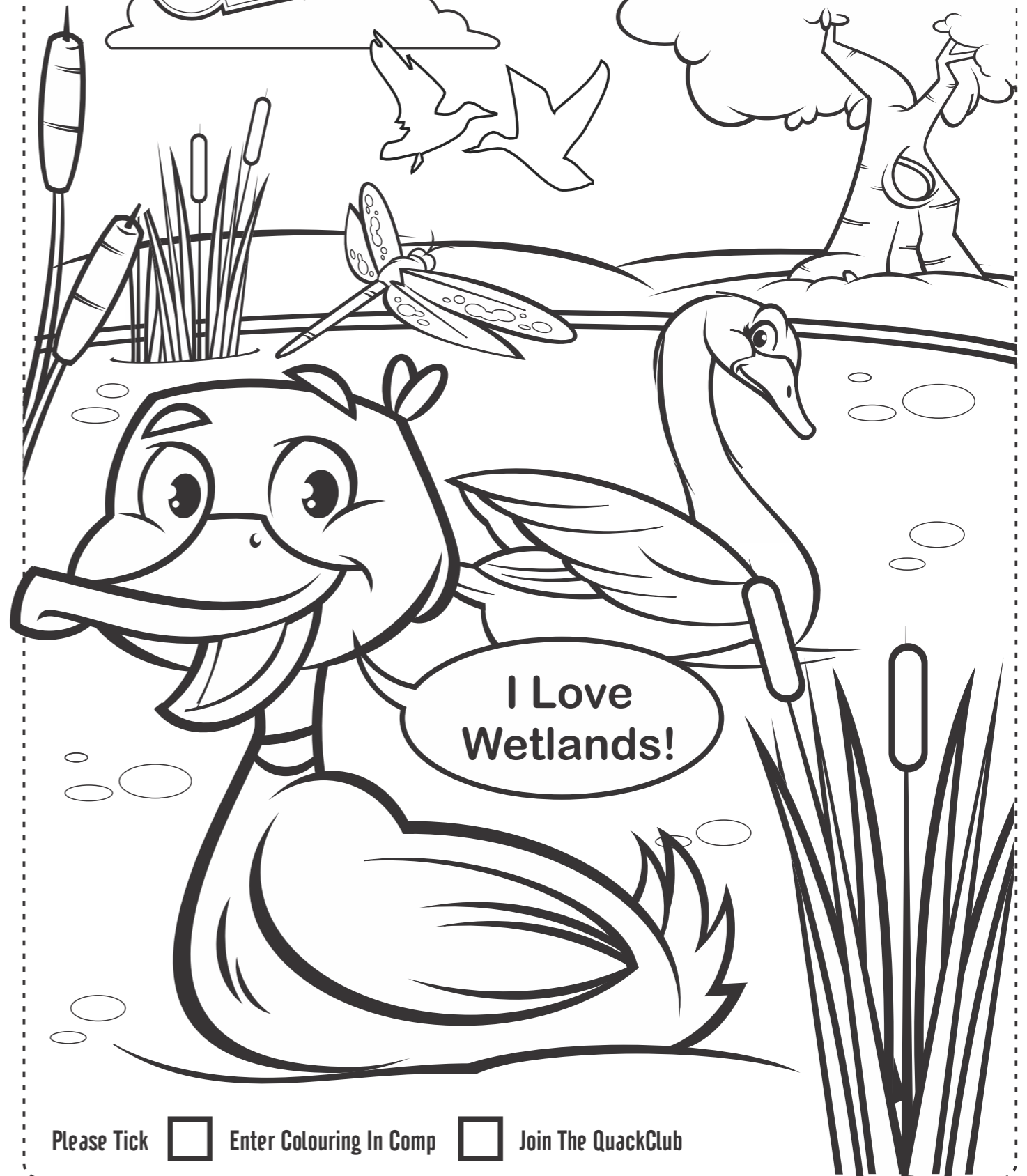
Due to over farming and need for land by humans, the existence of wetlands is in decline and they need our special effort to ensure these are around for you when you are older.

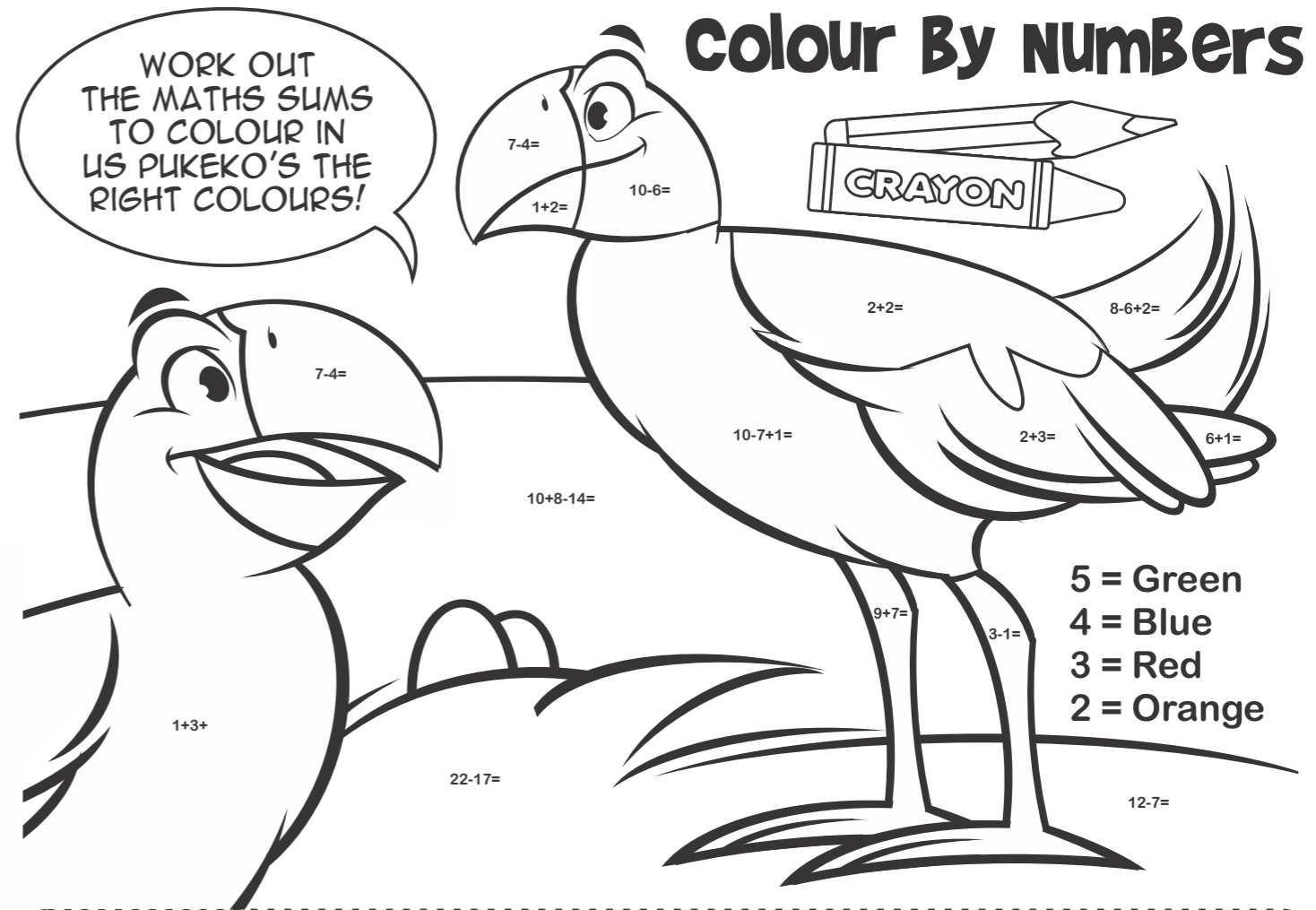
